Who is eligible?	Athletes living or attending school in the Far West Region
What area is the Far West Region?	This area stretches from Broken Hill in the West to Lightning Ridge in the East, Ivanhoe in the South, and Enngonia in the North. The region covers nine local government areas including: Bogan, Bourke, Brewarrina, Broken Hill, Central Darling, Cobar, Lightning Ridge, Walgett, Warren as well as the Un-incorporated area of NSW. Members of neighbouring communities whose sporting bodies identify with the Far West Region are also included. In particular these local government areas include Carrathool, Coonamble, Gilgandra, Lachlan, Moree Plains and Narromine.

Selection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athlete must be a member of a golf club in the far west region of NSW and have a handicap which has been broken from the maximum allocation • Athlete must be participating regularly in local golf competitions • Athlete is required to supply recent school records showing scholastic achievement levels and attendance records. <i>(this may be in the form of a letter or school report)</i>. Or athlete must be in meaningful work and supply a letter from your employer supporting your application to be selected in the 2009/10 FWAS Golf Program. • Talent and ability as a Golfer • Potential to develop the skills of an elite Golfer • Commitment and dedication • Willingness to learn and to apply coaching ideas • Enthusiasm for the program as an individual and as a team member • Performance at nominated events (within the twelve months prior to selection to the squad) i.e Tournaments played in, local competition results • Tactical ability or knowledge as demonstrated in clinics or tournaments • Individual application in training and competition / Ability to rehabilitate from injury/illness • Physical attributes including height, power, agility, speed and endurance • To be considered for selection athletes must attend either the April or October Warren Junior Golf Camp
