Far West Academy

- Players need to be able to attend all scheduled events and activities when selected
- Commitment to the program is for 1 full season however, the majority of the program is during the off season.
- Players selected in the CRL Far West Academy squad will be required to pay a player levy for the program (\$150 approx) and will receive a CRL Academy kit
- Players selected in the CRL Far West Academy Development squad will be required to pay \$75 (approx) and will receive a training shirt, socks and shorts
- Further program details provided upon selection
