

Proving your identity

To register as an industry participant or combatant in combat sports in NSW you must prove your identity, date of birth and residential address.

Sport and Recreation uses the prescribed verification procedure (100 point check, pursuant to the Financial Transaction Reports Act 1988, for the purposes of obtaining an identification record for applicants.

You must establish your identity by providing documents certified as true copies of the original from the list below that add up to a minimum of 100 points. Originals may also be sighted by Sport and Recreation staff.
