how to get there

Directions

Groups will generally access the centre from either Kangaroo Point or Brooklyn. Instructions are provided for wharf collections from Kangaroo Point and Brooklyn. Please be advised that there are no regular ferry services to the centre. All ferries booked are chartered. Please be on time.



Kangaroo Point or Brooklyn From Sydney

- Head north on the main Newcastle freeway (F3)
- As you cross the main bridge over the Hawkesbury River take the left hand exit to Mooney Mooney and Brooklyn
- Go straight through the roundabout, under the Freeway, and head to the old Pacific highway
- Turn right on the old Pacific Highway and cross back over the Hawkesbury River
- Take the first left turn after the bridge for Kangaroo Point.

From Newcastle

- As you approach the Hawkesbury River Bridge take the left exit to Mooney Mooney and Brooklyn
- At the old Pacific Highway turn right and head across the river on the Old Pacific Highway
- Take the first left turn after the bridge for Kangaroo Point.

Deerubbun Reserve/Ruins Wharf From Sydney

- Head north on the main Newcastle freeway (F3)
- As you cross the main bridge over the Hawkesbury River take the left hand exit to Mooney Mooney and Brooklyn
- You will come to a round about behind the ambulance station
- Turn left at the roundabout (Peats Ferry Road) and drive about 200 – 300m along that road.
- You will pass a sewerage treatment works on your right
- Just past the sewerage treatment works you will see a sign on your right which says "Milson Island Parking – Authorised access only"
- To access Deerubbun Reserve follow Peats Ferry Road to the end.

From Newcastle and the Central Coast

- As you approach the Hawkesbury River Bridge take the left exit to Mooney Mooney and Brooklyn.
- When you get to the old Pacific Highway turn left and head back towards Newcastle. You only go about 300m then take the first turn left under the main freeway
- You will pass an entrance to Peat Island on your right – a facility managed by Family and Community Services
- At the roundabout take the right exit (if you go straight through you will end up heading north on the freeway again)
- About 200 – 300m along that road you will pass a sewerage treatment works on your right
- Just past the sewerage treatment works you will see a sign on your right which says "Milson Island Parking – Authorised access only"
- To access Deerubbun Reserve follow Peats Ferry Road to the end.
